

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT SAFETY WARNINGS

- Place the product on flat and solid surface and keep at least 0.6 m free space around the product.
- Kids can move around this product only under adult supervision.
- Use only well-grounded socket and proper power cord.
- Pull out the plug after every use or during maintenance to avoid injury or damaging the product.
- Please use this product according to the manual.
- Do not use unauthorized modifications or accessories.
- Only for indoor use.
- Before first use, please read the manual carefully.
- Use this product as is described in the manual.
- Recommended maximum use time is 20 minutes.
- Do not use the device if it is damaged. (frame, leather etc.)
- Do not use the chair if the ventilation is blocked.
- No not put on chair heavy items or objects with sharp edge.
- Do not fall asleep during massage for safety reasons.
- Do not use the chair after you consumed alcohol or other drugs or if you are sick or dizzy.
- Do not use within one hour after meal.
- Please be caution and do not use too strong massage.
- Weight limit: 150 kg

POSITION OF MASSAGE CHAIR

- Do not use the chair in high temperatures or moist environments (e.g. bathroom).
- Do not use the chair immediately after temperature change.
- Do not use in dust or impropriety rooms.
- In is important to secure enough space and ventilation.

PEOPLE THAT SOULD NOT USE THE PRODUCT

- People suffering from osteoporosis.
- People who have hearth problems or are using electronic medical equipment (e.g. peacemaker).
- People suffering fever.
- Pregnant women.
- People suffering skin diseases.
- Kids younger 14 years old or people suffering mental illness can use this product only under adult supervision.
- People that are recommended rest from the doctor or people suffering from sickness.
- Do not use this chair if you have wet body.
- Do not use the heat function if you are heat sensitive.

SAFETY


- Maintenance should be done only by qualify person. Use should not disassemble the chair or do the maintenance by themselves.
- After every use unplug the cord.
- Do not use the product if the power cord, plug or socked are damaged.
- If you are not using the chair for long period of time, store it at a clean and dry place and secure the power cord.
- Do not expose the chair to high temperatures, direct sunlight and do not place the chair near heat source.
- If the power cord, plug or socked are damaged, ask professional or qualified person for help.
- For cleaning use wet sponge only. Do not use thinner, gasoline or alcohol for cleaning.
- Mechanical parts are assembled and made to require minimum maintenance.
- Pay extra attention to not damage the chair with sharp objects.
- Do not push the chair on uneven ground, always pick the chair up and then move.
- Do not let the chair to work for long periods of time.

COMMON PROBLEMS AND SOLUTIONS


- It is common that the motor is making sounds.
- If the chair is not working, please check the power cord, plug and socket and that the switch is ON.
- After the massage time is over the massage chair will turn OFF. The product will automatically shut down if it is overheated wait at least half an hour before next massage.

WARNING


If the footrest rises, do not apply pressure to the footrest. You may damage the product or injure yourself.




Never unplug the power cord during use or when the chair is in standby mode. After use, we recommend switching off the chair and unplugging the power cord.




Before sitting down, make sure that the massage heads do not protrude from the seat. You may damage the heads or be injured.




Before using the angle adjustment function, make sure that you have enough free space and that there are no other people or pets behind the chair.



FUNCTION

- The massage chair contains massage heads powered by four-wheel drive that move up and down with quiet operation.
- 5 types of massages: fingers, kneading, tapping, knocking, and kneading.
- Automatic arm detection.
- 12 types of preset automatic massages: comfortable, relaxing, traction, shoulders and neck, back and waist, full body, vertebral, recovery, stretching, collateral activation, buttocks massage, soothing, total air cushion massage.
- Manual massage: full body, fixative, selective; 5 speed settings. You can adjust the position up and down during the fixed massage; you can adjust the width while knocking, pushing, or tapping.
- Air massage: 3 modes and 3 levels of intensity selection; body pressure, arm pressure, leg pressure.
- Foot massage using rollers.
- Adjustable footrests.
- Back heating with carbon fibers.
- Backrest on the rail, which reduces the required space when tilting.
- · Ergonomic backrest.
- Play music through Bluetooth speakers.
- Voice control.
- There are 5 buttons on the left back for quick control.
- Massage and magnetic palm massage.
- There is a USB charging port on the right side of the handle.
- Backlight.
- Controller with LCD color display.
- Automatic shutdown.




Diagram of power supply and fuses

STARTING THE MASSAGE

- 1. Press the power button, the default massage setting is comfort.
- 2. The massage chair automatically adjusts the position of the shoulders.
- 3. Automatic shoulder detection starts, be seated correctly.
- 4. If the position of the arms is detected incorrectly, you can move the position of the heads manually up and down. You can choose between 10 positions, if the change is not made within 10 seconds, the massage will start automatically.

Button	Description	Display
1	Move the massage heads up.

During **shoulder** detection, an audible signal sounds, during which you can adjust the position of the heads. You can also choose one of 12 preset massages: comfortable, relaxing, traction, shoulders and neck, back and waist, full body, vertebral, recovery, stretching, collateral activation, buttocks massage, soothing, total air cushion massage.





VOICE CONTROL

Voice control of the chair is in English only.

If the chair is turned on or in standby mode, say "Hi Alice" to start voice control. After starting the voice control, you have 6 seconds to enter the next command. After 6 seconds, the voice control switches off again.

BLUETOOTH

Find your new device on your phone. The chair will be called IMCM-XXXX (X is the unique number of the chair). Pair the chair with your phone and you can play music from your phone.

SWITCH OFF


Switch off the chair, the rests return to their original positions. Unplug the chair.






LEG REST ATTACHMENT

Connect the cables and hoses and insert them so that you do not pinch them (Fig. 1). Attach the leg rest to the bracket (Fig. 2).




Attach the cover (Fig. 3).

Attach the cover with the M4 screw (Fig. 4).




PILLOWS

The cushions are fastened with a zipper for the backrest (1), the cushions for the headrest with Velcro (2).



FLOOR PROTECTION

We recommend using floor protection such as carpets or mats. The weight of the chair could damage the wooden floor.




TRANSPORT

Before moving, make sure that you have switched off the chair and pulled it out of the el. current.

Push on the backrest, the chair will stand on the wheels.

This move is only for a short distance, use auxiliary tools and more people to move for longer distances.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF WARRANTY, WARRANTY CLAIMS

General Conditions of Warranty and Definition of Terms

All Warranty Conditions stated here under determine Warranty Coverage and Warranty Claim Procedure. Conditions of Warranty and Warranty Claims are governed by Act No. 89/2012 Coll. Civil Code, and Act No. 634/1992 Coll., Consumer Protection, as amended, also in cases that are not specified by these Warranty rules.

The seller is SEVEN SPORT s.r.o. with its registered office in Strakonická street 1151/2c, Prague 150 00, Company Registration Number: 26847264, registered in the Trade Register at Regional Court in Prague, Section C, Insert No. 116888.

According to valid legal regulations it depends whether the Buyer is the End Customer or not.

"The Buyer who is the End Customer" or simply the "End Customer" is the legal entity that does not conclude and execute the Contract in order to run or promote his own trade or business activities.

"The Buyer who is not the End Customer" is a Businessman that buys Goods or uses services for the purpose of using the Goods or services for his own business activities. The Buyer conforms to the General Purchase Agreement and business conditions.

These Conditions of Warranty and Warranty Claims are an integral part of every Purchase Agreement made between the Seller and the Buyer. All Warranty Conditions are valid and binding, unless otherwise specified in the Purchase Agreement, in the Amendment to this Contract or in another written agreement.

Warranty Conditions

Warranty Period

The Seller provides the Buyer a 24 months Warranty for Goods Quality, unless otherwise specified in the Certificate of Warranty, Invoice, Bill of Delivery or other documents related to the Goods. The legal warranty period provided to the Consumer is not affected.

By the Warranty for Goods Quality, the Seller guarantees that the delivered Goods shall be, for a certain period of time, suitable for regular or contracted use, and that the Goods shall maintain its regular or contracted features.

Batteries

6-month battery warranty – we guarantee that battery's nominal capacity does not fall below 70% of its total capacity within 6 months of the product's sale.

The Warranty does not cover defects resulting from (if applicable):

- User's fault, i.e. product damage caused by unqualified repair work, improper assembly, insufficient insertion of seat post into frame, insufficient tightening of pedals and cranks
- Improper maintenance
- Mechanical damages
- Regular use (e.g. wearing out of rubber and plastic parts, moving mechanisms, joints, wear of brake pads/blocks, chain, tires, cassette/multi wheel etc.)
- Unavoidable event, natural disaster
- Adjustments made by unqualified person
- Improper maintenance, improper placement, damages caused by low or high temperature, water, inappropriate pressure, shocks, intentional changes in design or construction etc.

Warranty Claim Procedure

The Buyer is obliged to check the Goods delivered by the Seller immediately after taking the responsibility for the Goods and its damages, i.e. immediately after its delivery. The Buyer must check the Goods so that he discovers all the defects that can be discovered by such check.

When making a Warranty Claim the Buyer is obliged, on request of the Seller, to prove the purchase and validity of the claim by the Invoice or Bill of Delivery that includes the product's serial number, or eventually by the documents without the serial number. If the Buyer does not prove the validity of the Warranty Claim by these documents, the Seller has the right to reject the Warranty Claim.

If the Buyer gives notice of a defect that is not covered by the Warranty (e.g. in the case that the Warranty Conditions were not fulfilled or in the case of reporting the defect by mistake etc.), the Seller is eligible to require a compensation for all the costs arising from the repair. The cost shall be calculated according to the valid price list of services and transport costs.

If the Seller finds out (by testing) that the product is not damaged, the Warranty Claim is not accepted. The Seller reserves the right to claim a compensation for costs arising from the false Warranty Claim.

In case the Buyer makes a claim about the Goods that is legally covered by the Warranty provided by the Seller, the Seller shall fix the reported defects by means of repair or by the exchange of the damaged part or product for a new one. Based on the agreement of the Buyer, the Seller has the right to exchange the defected Goods for a fully compatible Goods of the same or better technical characteristics. The Seller is entitled to choose the form of the Warranty Claim Procedures described in this paragraph.

The Seller shall settle the Warranty Claim within 30 days after the delivery of the defective Goods, unless a longer period has been agreed upon. The day when the repaired or exchanged Goods is handed over to the Buyer is considered to be the day of the Warranty Claim settlement. When the

Seller is not able to settle the Warranty Claim within the agreed period due to the specific nature of the Goods defect, he and the Buyer shall make an agreement about an alternative solution. In case such agreement is not made, the Seller is obliged to provide the Buyer with a financial compensation in the form of a refund.
